Description

Description: An exceptional and rare 18th-century etching and engraving titled "Les Accords Flamands". This masterpiece was engraved by Jacques-Philippe Le Bas (1707-1783), the renowned Graveur du Cabinet du Roi, after the celebrated painting by David Teniers the Younger (1610-1690).

This work is a perfect representation of the Flemish spirit, depicting a lively village festival with extraordinary technical precision. The depth of the blacks and the delicate treatment of the characters make it a true museum-quality piece.
