CAMIADE JEANINE MARIE (1879-1964) Painter of portraits and landscapes. Marie Jeanne CAMIADE, was born on May 28, 1879 in Bayonne, 40, rue des Basques. Around 1892-1896: Jeanine CAMIADE was a student of Georges Bergès at the Municipal School of Drawing in Bayonne. 1908: in October, a teaching position for girls was created at the Municipal School of Drawing and Painting in Bayonne. "A competition will be organized soon." This school is located in the Lebas building, Allées Boufflers, on the ground floor. Salary: 1,000 F, Pascau: 3,000 F. At that time, Eugène Pascau had been the director of this school for a year. 1909: This competition was not mentioned in the deliberations of the Municipal Council in 1908 and 1909. o 1911: She was a
