A rare and highly collectible Royal Doulton Art Decovase from the renowned Mandarin Ware series, designed by Robert Allen around 1920. Finely hand-painted with a vibrant flamingo and stylized flowers, set against a rare white ground with the characteristic bold black rim - a hallmark of Allen's design. The Mandarin Ware line was exhibited internationally and exported to Europe and the USA, admired for its rich enamels, durable decoration, and complex hand-painting technique. Works by Allen and other artists for this series are regarded as more important and artistically significant - and command higher prices - than standard Doulton wares of the period. The vase is robustly potted (shape 1256D), marked underneath with the impressed shape number, pattern code, factory
