Iranian rug from the Fars region (southwest Iran), wool, cotton warp and weft, circa 1960. Very good condition. A traditional navy blue central medallion stands out against a red background dotted with flowers and plants. Three borders frame the field of the rug. The Gashghai confederation includes different tribes. Some examples: the Kashkulis Bozorgs (the large ones), the Kashkulis Kucheks (the small ones), the Shishbolukis (six districts), the Amalehs or Yalamehs (workers, servants of the Khan).
