Details:

These spurs were standard issue for mounted troops and gendarmerie, built for practical field use. The clean, utilitarian design, absence of decorative markings, and rounded button pegs are typical of enlisted cavalry gear. A small eyelet on the side may have once secured a leather keeper or tag.
