Immersed in an Arcadian landscape, four children are playing blind man's buff, a metaphor for the lightheartedness of youth and an iconographic reference to the blindfolded Cupid. The painting combines delicate tones and compositional grace with a particularly sought-after theme in 18th-century Rococo collecting. The quality and subject matter of the artwork recall the models of the great Piedmontese painter Vittorio Amedeo Rapous (1729-1819). Active primarily in Turin at the Savoy court, he is known for his decorative and allegorical works featuring playful scenes of cherubs. (The painting does not currently come
