Ejagham or Ekoi mask, south-east of Nigeria or west of Cameroon, they are the only ones to make this kind of mask in Africa wooden masks covered with skin, facial ones like this one (the rarest) are quite expressive war masks. We find many in the form of a crest with long braids, they are often decorative masks. These masks are either worn on the face or held, they came to replace the real human heads that the warriors wore as trophies. Height 40 cm (not including the base), wear and cracks, first half of the last century, with its beautiful base provided with. The photos are a little shiny because of the spots.
