This beautiful rug in collector's condition has the attributes of the wonderful prayer-shaped Tehran intended for decoration rather than worship. A very beautiful niche with an ivory background is decorated with a vase placed on a large pendant. It releases a bouquet of stylized flowers, representing the tree of life, surrounded by abundantly flowered branches in many selected shades. These shades are those that are regularly found on this type of rug and specifically on the Tehran. Mainly, wine lees, many blues, ivory, pink and eggplant color# A vase in the center of the carpet is fully

inscribed, it represents the ancient attribute of the Sumerian goddess of water in the third millennium. A vase from which water springs, the motif has remained until today, in oriental art, but it has lost its original meaning. A group of Persian antique carpets of the most extraordinary is that of the carpets called "with a vase". The vase is a pretext for an overflow, a floral springing, in arabesques with volutes. The vase associated with the tree of life, is found on the Persians of the type, Tabriz, Kashan, Macchad, but also on Turkish interpretations, in Ottoman carpets and the marvelous silks of Kashmir.Over the centuries, the decoration has moved away from the original decoration. The border, richly flowered, testifies, like the whole of this piece, to the mastery of the craftsman who knotted it. The short fringes and the edges in perfect condition, renovated a few years ago, an impeccable velvet and fresh shades, offer us a carpet of great and beautiful quality of a hundred years for approximately 600,000 knots per M2. The velvet in a magnificent state of conservation. The revival of carpet production began with carpets that are distinguished by the superior quality of the wool giving an extremely velvety appearance. The decorations are varied and offer a meticulous invoice: hunting scenes, subjects with figures inspired by Persian mythology, birds in a plant decoration, trees of life. Thanks to the superior quality of the wool, their tight knotting, the beauty of their natural colors and their designs, the Tehran take their place among the best and least known of Persian carpets## Tehran is the capital of Iran. It is located in the north of the country. The Golestan Palace Complex (Museum), with its ornate rooms and marble throne, is located in the city center and was once the seat of the powerful Qajar dynasty. The National Jewels Museum houses many of the jewels of the Qajar monarchs, while the National Museum of Iran displays artifacts dating back to the Paleolithic era.
