Large pair of French Restoration period candelabras circa 1820 with four lights in bronze with a double patina, gilded and burnished. Overhung by a central candlestick, three arms of light, decorated with foliage, volutes and acanthus leaves come to support chalices with finely chiseled bobèches. The fluted shaft is decorated with a column capital at the top, a baluster base delicately chiseled with acanthus leaves and palmettes motif, fluted shaft. Tripod base with lion's paws. Each socket has its original bobèche as well as a damper as a flame for each candelabra. Height: 57.5 cm. Well-proportioned set and beautiful luminosity, these candelabras with meticulous chiseling work will impose their charisma by their large size and their contrasting patinas. Very
