Description

Antique painting signed by the Belgian artist Pauline Jamar (1850-1909). Artist known for her delicate floral compositions. This is an oil on canvas depicting a bouquet of flowers (probably cinerarias) in blue, white and purple tones. The style is naturalistic and very representative of 19th-century painting. The canvas is presented in its original period giltwood frame, richly decorated with plant motifs and pearls, in the Napoleon III style. The frame measures 69 cm x 54 cm, while the canvas stretcher measures 53 cm x 37 cm. The artist's signature is clearly visible at the bottom right. Canvas in very good condition, old restorations to be noted. Pauline Jamar (1850-1909) is a Belgian painter from Liège, known for her floral still lifes, landscapes and decorative watercolors. Marcke, she exhibited in several Belgian salons from 1878 and was an active member of the Circle of Women Painters and the Royal Circle of Fine Arts of Liège. Her delicate and naturalistic style reflects the 19th-century taste for refined floral painting. Her works are now held in several institutions, including the Museum of Fine Arts of Liège (BAL), the Museum of Walloon Life, and the City of Seraing, testifying to her regional roots and her recognition in Belgian artistic heritage.
