In reality, its flowering begins in summer and ends in early autumn. Its flower is campanulate and has five teeth. Although generally deep purple, it is sometimes white, especially when cultivated. Among the cultivated varieties, the best known are Hina-kikyo, Sawa-kikyo, Iwa-kikyo and Chishima-kikyo. Thanks to rapid cultivation, these varieties are commercially available around May-June
