Description

Attributed to Filippo Puglieschi Rome, first half of the 19th century. Exquisite Roman micromosaic plaque of exceptional quality, depicting a lively encounter between a hunting dog and a cat in a moment of dynamic tension, set in a woodland landscape with classical architectural elements in the background. The extremely fine tesserae are laid with remarkable skill, creating a near-painterly effect. The soft color transitions and luminous tones lend the scene a remarkable depth and naturalism. Notable is the detailed rendering of the animals' fur, the foliage, and the play of light. The technical finesse and the refined narrative composition suggest an attribution to Filippo Puglieschi, a Roman mosaicist active in the first half of the 19th century, known for naturalistic subjects and highly detailed
