Description

This fragment is an oil on canvas glued to metal, dating from the 19th century, probably from a larger ensemble, such as an altarpiece or a polyptych. Our work represents a scene of the "Carrying of the Cross", a central theme of the Passion of Christ. This iconography is very common in Renaissance painting, particularly among artists from Northern Europe. The piece, of irregular shape, shows a young man dressed in a light gray tunic and a green loincloth, girded with a purple rope. He seems to be carrying a beam or a piece of cross on his shoulder, which evokes a religious scene, perhaps the ascent to Calvary. In the background, we can partially distinguish the face of a veiled figure, man or woman ... The fragment is now presented on a modern black support which allows its exhibition.
