### Description

This sumptuous Bakhtiar rug features a refined design, hand-knotted by the nomadic Bakhtiari tribe. It consists of a central field structured into a grid of regular squares, each adorned with meticulously woven motifs depicting animals, birds, floral bouquets, and stylized natural scenes. The design of its ornaments is inspired by Persian gardens. These motifs evoke the richness of Persian flora and fauna, symbols of harmony and abundance. The dominant colors include shades of brick red, midnight blue, ivory, golden ochre, and green, subtly balanced to create a warm yet dynamic visual effect. Each square is framed by fine borders accentuating the symmetry of the overall design. The richly decorated main border surrounds the rug with a tangle of flowers, foliage, and stylized motifs on an ivory
