Description

A refined 19th century French Louis XVI style commode, crafted with a beechwood structure and veneered in warm-toned walnut arranged in elegant chevron and quarter-turn patterns. This graceful piece features three drawers -- two deep and one shallow -- adorned with finely chased gilt bronze hardware, including rosettes, ribboned escutcheons, and neoclassical keyhole mounts. The top is crowned with a striking Breccia marble slab in a beautifully veined palette of soft lilac, ivory, green, and golden tones, offering a luxurious contrast with the warm wood grain. Gilt-bronze mounts highlight the neoclassical lines of the piece, with fluted corner posts decorated with lyre-shaped appliqués and feet terminating in lion paw sabots.
