



## A. Meunier - Pair Of Miniature Bronzes With Putti

### Description

Evoking all the grace and lightness of the 19th-century neo-rococo aesthetic, this delicate pair of miniature bronze putti is distinguished by the finesse of its modeling and the timeless charm of its childlike figures. Each putto, nude, set in a natural posture, embodies an ideal of innocence and elegance dear to the artists of the Second Empire and the Third Republic. The deep, silky brown patina highlights the soft volumes of the bronze, while the circular gilded wood bases enhance the ensemble with a subtle shine, evoking the refined presentations of 19th-century amateur cabinets. One of the two subjects bears the signature "A. Meunier", although the artist could not be identified with certainty. He was probably a sculptor active in the 1870s-1890s, part of the tradition of small decorative bronzes
