at the École des Beaux-Arts in Lyon. She began

her career as a textile designer in Lyon before

moving to Provence in the mid-1930s. She

learned the art of ceramics with the potter

Jean-Baptiste Chiapello and then founded the

Madoura workshop in Vallauris in 1938 with her

husband Georges Ramié, an acronym composed

of the first letters of the words maison, Douly and

Ramié. Breaking with the tradition of utilitarian

objects produced by local potters, she produced

works with refined and original forms and
