Let yourself be charmed by the timeless grace of this porcelain bather. Inspired by the art of James Pradier, whose real name was Jean-Jacques Pradier, a major 19th-century Franco-Swiss sculptor (1790-1852). He was born in Geneva but spent most of his career in France. He won the prestigious Prix de Rome in 1813, which allowed him to stay at the Villa Medici for several years (1814-1819). He is known for his skill in combining the purity of classical forms with a certain sensuality and emotional expressiveness. His work is often described as elegant and graceful. Some have even nicknamed him "the last of the Greeks" for his mastery of the ancient style. Presented here is a piece signed by VILLENAUXE-LA-GRANDE that will bring a touch of poetry and refinement to your interior.
