This Villeroy & Boch tea service, dating from the Saar Union period (circa 1950s-1970s), is distinguished by its elegant pattern of red flowers on a cream background, typical of the decorative style of this period. It is designed for six people, including several cups, saucers, a teapot, a sugar bowl, and a creamer. This service consists of a coffee pot, a teapot with 6 cups and saucers, a sugar bowl, and a creamer. In perfect condition Saar Union: The term Saar Union refers to the economic union that was established by France to reorganize the region's industries, including ceramics. This period was marked by a reorganization of production and a strengthening of ties between French industries and companies in the Saarland, of which Villeroy & Boch was a part.
