Large solid silver stew spoon, 1st rooster hallmark. 18th-19th centuries 280 Solid silver stew spoon, filet model, dating from the late 18th or early 19th century. It is hallmarked: 1st rooster hallmark for 950/°° silver, used in Paris between 1798 and 1809. Old Man's head hallmark on the front for the guaranteed Parisian average mark.

Poorly struck silversmith's hallmark to be identified, probably ALA with a flower as a mark. Beautiful spoon of a classic model but of very good craftsmanship, it is thick and heavy, a sign of quality. 32.5 cm long 184.59 grams. Good condition. Scratches from use.
