Born into a modest family, his father died, and he spent his childhood in an orphanage. He devoted himself to art as a self-taught artist. At a young age, he worked with

the marble worker Stefano Furati and the Ravenna-born sculptor Attilio Maltoni (1862-1909). A student of Alessandro Mazzarenti (1846-1923) in Ravenna, he moved to Turin and worked in Pietro Canonica's studio as a marble rough-hewer. He began his career as a sculptor, exhibiting, starting in 1900, at the exhibitions of the Promotrice delle Belle Arti in Turin. He received numerous prizes and awards in Italy, Europe, and South America.

Humanity Against Evil, a work of great plastic expressiveness, presented in plaster in Milan in 1906, realized in marble in 1908, re-presented in Buenos Aires in 1910, is housed at the Galleria d'Arte Moderna in Rome.

In 1920, he created the Monument to Saint John Bosco, in front of the Basilica of Mary Help of Christians in Turin. He also created the tondo for the saint's urn. The War Memorial in Carmagnola (Turin) dates from 1921. Between 1928 and 1930, he created the War Memorial in Asti.

In 2006, an exhibition on the artist Gaetano Cellini was held in the Exhibition Hall of the Basilica of Mary Help of Christians.
