The subject is depicted in the ceremonial attire typical of nobility and senatorial rank, wearing the sumptuous senatorial fur cape and a bib embroidered with gold floral motifs, a faithful expression of the high lineage and social prestige of the era. The watercolor technique uses soft brushstrokes and refined details, highlighting the rich textures and colors of the fabrics: the soft effect of the fur, the brilliance of the gold details, and the realistic folds of the clothing contribute to imbuing the work with remarkable depth and verisimilitude.
