She holds the head of a slain wild boar in her arms -- a symbol of her hunting prowess -while a loyal hound stands affectionately at her side. A quiver full of arrows is slung across her back, a classic attribute of the goddess. The execution is of outstanding quality, with flowing drapery, finely worked animal details, and a serene facial expression. The neoclassical style and mythological subject matter situate this piece in the mid-19th century, likely created in an Austro-German workshop, renowned for luxury
