Charming and finely turned pocket watch stand in ebonized fruitwood, of English origin and datable to the early 19th century, during the Victorian era or late Empire period. With its understated elegance, this small stand was designed to hold a pocket watch overnight, transforming it into a miniature bedside or mantel clock. The circular base, gently flared (diameter 9.5 cm), is delicately decorated with small stylized floral motifs in gilt and gold powder. The tilted top tray, equipped with a brass hook to support the watch, features a subtle circular gilt border and retains a lovely antique patina. Entirely hand-turned, this piece reflects the quality craftsmanship of early 19th-century English production.
