### Description

Elegant large-format majolica parade plate (diameter 37 cm), made in Central Italy - likely between Umbria and the Marche region - between the late 19th and early 20th century. Entirely hand-painted with refined technique, it features an elaborate grotesque design inspired by Renaissance motifs, including winged figures, fantastic beasts, stylized floral elements and symmetrical ornamental details. At the center is a noble coat of arms, divided into two fields: the upper part shows a black eagle on a gold background, symbol of imperial nobility; the lower part depicts a male bust blowing a flame beside a wheel, likely a heraldic or family symbol. Above the shield, a crowned and plumed helmet follows classic heraldic tradition. The outer rim is bordered with a continuous

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decorative frieze in blue and yellow. The reverse side has two original holes for wall-mounting. The glaze has a natural antique crazing, with no visible restorations. Diameter: 37 cm Very good overall condition, with minor signs of age.
