Bare-chested, expressive face, our portrait represents the future emperor as a statesmanA work probably NeapolitanMade after an antique, our work was probably cast in Naples by the workshop J CHIURAZZI and son. This foundry was the most important of the 19th century for antique-style bronze objects. The success of the Grand Tour for any good person of the 19th century allowed the development of a large production of souvenirs from Italy. Roman finds were not the only ones
