Description

Beautiful painting from nature on the coast of Granville, made in 1847 by Louis Désiré Thiénon, French painter of the 19th century. This oil on panel (42 x 32 cm) illustrates a lively scene of the Normandy coast, precisely at the level of the point of Roc. The scene is animated by several figures, including a child, in the foreground, dressed in a white shirt, blowing into a large shell. In the distance, other bathers and walkers walk among the rocks. The sky is bright, the rough sea hits the shore in an expressive and vibrant touch. The whole gives off an intense and poetic atmosphere, mixing naturalist observation and a sense of the picturesque. Signed and dated lower left: "Louis Thienon / Granville 1847". An annotation by the painter on the back of the panel. The work is presented in a gilded carved wooden
