Description

Goblet-shaped cup decorated with stars in its lower part and with scrolls and palmettes in its upper part. A cartouche, decorated with leaf motifs, bears a number (RC?) largely erased. Minerva hallmark of 1st title and partially erased hallmark of the silversmiths Charles Hack and Achille Hourdequin (H&H, two axes in saltire between the initials), active in Paris at 42 rue de Turbigo from 1884 to 1902. Two small dents in the lower part. Good general condition. From the late 19th century. Dimensions: H: 8 cm D: 6.5 cm (neck) - 5 cm (base) Net weight: 75 gr
