Meissen porcelain jug, mid-19th century. Ribbed, bulbous body with flared rim and wide, flat shoulder. Relief band with geometric cross-hatch and meander ornament around the neck. Curved branch handle with applied gold petals. Spout decorated with gold stylized leaves. Each side decorated with two birds on a branch, surrounded by insects: beetles, butterflies, bees. Continues the Meissen "Naturalistic Birds and Insects" series first created after the 1740s and produced in small numbers through the 19th century.
