Each glass holder is topped with openwork pinnacles intended to hold the containers in place. The set is complete with its two engraved crystal saucers, with sloping rims highlighted with a gilt rim. Height: 10.5 cm Diameter at the rim: 6.4 cm Capacity: 100 ml 875/1000 silver mount, hallmarked Weight of the mounts: 98 g Very good condition - slight wear to the gilding on the rim of one of the saucers.
