Elipson, was a company founded in 1938, is the oldest brand specialized in the manufacture of high-end French acoustic speakers. Joseph Léon was the true creator of the company and its transformation towards acoustics. It was he who created and sculpted the Elipson sound by experimenting in all directions with staff shapes, sound reflectors, spheres, conches. Joseph Léon (1908-1984) gained professional recognition during the period 1940-1973, by equipping the entire ORTF,

through his three years of work in the RTF acoustics laboratories. At the same time, Elipson equipped the French pavilion at the 1958 World's Fair. Public recognition came to Elipson after 1967, with the legendary model, the BS404, a 40 cm, two-way sphere, which arrived as the must-have in home hi-fi.
