- Pocket or pocket watch in solid silver, chased and guilloché, bowl decorated with green gold-plated leaves, pink gold-plated flowers, scrolls and a blank shield, pink gold-plated initials and its white metal protective box.- French crab title hallmark expressed in thousandths in use in France from 1834 to 1984 present on the front of the pendant head, bowl, dust cover and on the edge of the pocket watch case and the different from the precious metals control guarantee office of Besançon in the Doubs department (25).- Diamond-shaped goldsmith's hallmark on the bowl to be identified with two letters S&C and a rooster between the two letters inside the diamond-shaped hallmark, number 29515 and the number 4 on the bowl and the dust cover engraved in hollow. - Smooth

octagonal watch edge and guilloché and chiseled pocket watch bezel surround, brass crown winder, slightly domed and beveled mineral glass. - White enamel dial, black-painted Roman numerals for the hours, gold-colored index graduation for the hours and minutes, gilt metal Louis XV hands. - Small seconds dial at six o'clock, black-painted Arabic numerals and railway graduation for the seconds and blued metal second hand. - Gilt brass movement set with rubies with cylinder escapement, blued steel screws, crown wheel, ratchet, ratchet pawl, advance and retard index in polished steel and located above the balance wheel. Winding on the pendant and setting the time by pressing the small push button located to the left of the pendant head while simultaneously turning the winding crown clockwise. - In perfect working order, serviced by a watchmaker. - Protective tin box, plastic glass with the word argus dépôt and the number 21 on the back of the box engraved in the metal. - Open and close the box by pressing the button on the right side of the box. - Period end of the 19th century around 1885-1900. - Gross weight: 60.20 gr.
