"Edmond Milleur", oil on canvas, 1874 This 1874 oil painting of Edmond Milleur captures a striking male portrait. The subject, depicted half-length, emerges from a dark, uniform background that accentuates his figure. His expression is serious and solemn, accentuated by his thick, dark beard that merges with an imposing mustache, creating an image of authority and dignity. The man wears a dark military uniform, embellished with gold details that suggest his rank. His epaulettes stand out on his shoulders, one of which, on the left, is adorned with gold fringes, a distinctive sign of high rank. The jacket is buttoned at the collar with gold buttons, and a medal, a red and white decoration, attests to merit or accomplished achievements, is pinned to his chest. The portrait

is framed in an oval frame, a classic 19th-century portraiture device that focuses attention on the sitter's face. This frame, in turn, is set in a sumptuous gilded rectangular frame, richly adorned with acanthus leaf and scroll motifs, typical of the eclectic taste of the era. The presence, on the back, of a label written by the son adds a further layer of history and personal affection, making the work not only a portrait, but a precious family heirloom.
