Pair of vases Glazed earthenware and gilded metal mount Dimensions: H. 40 (cm.) Sèvres circa 1920 Large pair of slender vases in royal blue earthenware with water green. Mounted with openwork floral friezes. Signed under the base with two crossed Ls. Paul Milet at SèvresFamous ceramist, his success was made possible by his training as a chemist, but also by his artistic vision, for example, by maintaining a dialogue with artists at the Sèvres factory. He won a gold medal at the 1900 Universal Exhibition and also took part in the Decorative Arts Exhibition. The PM Sèvres mark appeared in the 1930s, replacing the interlaced Ls that he could no longer use.
