Large Louis XV period solid silver wine taster, model with twisted ribs highlighted with dots, the serpentine grip. Border engraved "DAVID ROZE DSF". Charge hallmarks (crowned A with branch under the jamb) and Discharge (open rose) for PARIS 1762-68, Countermark, Jurande hallmark for PARIS 1762 (Crowned Y) and Hallmark of Master Goldsmith Pierre-Antoine VIAUCOURT (Hallmark with the crowned Fleur-de-lis, two grains, his initials "PAV" and a shell) received in 1753. Large Louis XV period wine taster in very good condition and remarkably hallmarked, with a beautiful patina, micro-scratches of use. For the informed collector ...
