Description

Lovely little Louis XVI pewter fountain composed of 3 elements: a reservoir with its tap, the cover and the basin. The reservoir is equipped with 2 architectural handles on the sides to be able to hang it on a support. The tap is in bronze with a stylized spout. The cover has a typically Louis XIV style fretel as it was still done in the provinces long after the death of the great King. The back has 2 "CTAG" hallmarks and is dated "1785". The basin is oval in shape and is deep enough to serve as a hand basin. The perimeter is surrounded by decorative grooves. Very good general condition. The underside of the reservoir at the tap level has undergone a small old restoration. Beautiful and rare model for collector. Reservoir + cover: h: 30.2 cm.
