Arturo Faldi (Florence 1856-1911) He studied at the Academy of Fine Arts in Florence, where his teachers were Giovanni Muzzioli and Michele Gordigiani. Until 1880, he focused on historical-mythological genre painting. In 1881, with *La trecciaiuola*, he moved away from this genre and toward the style of the Macchiaioli. Following the success of the painting, exhibited under the title *Paysanne d'Italie* at the Paris Salon, he continued to focus on realistic subjects, often focusing on the relationship between peasant labor and nature. Two of his paintings were honored by King Umberto I: *Honeymoon*,
