Polychrome stoneware, circa 1930. René Beauclair (1877-1960): The man who calls himself René Beauclair has the baptismal name Ludovic-Jean-Joseph-Marie POPINEAU. He is in turn an architect, decorator, ceramist, sculptor, and painter. This southern artist who lives in Toulouse, Castelnau de Montmiral, made his name thanks to the publication of decorative models in the Art Nouveau style at the beginning of the 20th century. He produced a lot in the interwar period. Painter and decorator, he is also the author of numerous war memorials. He participated with talent in the production of decorative ceramics for Odetta in Quimper in the 1930s. He is one of the most prolific artists of the Odetta period. He produced many works in Toulouse and the Gaillac region. It is present at
