Rare large Normandy Wine Taster in solid silver from the Regency period with a swollen body. Characteristic thumb rest in a cut-out shape and engraved with a cherub holding a rock pick in both hands to free a Heart from a rock, all topped with the engraving "Petit à Petit". Border engraving "Genevieve Gosse" on one side and "N Lainé" on the other. Charge and Discharge Hallmark for ROUEN 1721-26, Common House Hallmark for ROUEN 1722 (I Crowned) and Hallmark (on thumb rest) of Master Goldsmith Antoine LAGENET received in 1715. Rare large Rouen Wine Taste from the Regency period in very good condition with beautiful engraving and well hallmarked, beautiful size with its + 113 grams.
