



Lithophane "the Two Chapels Between Lake And Mountain" Mid-19th Century

Description

Lithophany NPM 528 Dimensions: 7.5 x 9.5 cm
Two chapels face each other between a lake and a mountain. On the shore, a rider leaves the scene while a small sailboat sails on the lake. A lithophanie is a thin ceramic plate with a relief whose thickness varies from 1.5 to 4 mm. The porcelain is fired twice at a temperature of 1250 °C. In normal lighting, there is practically no visible image, but a three-dimensional image is created when a light is placed behind it.

Lithophanies became particularly popular in the mid-19th century. Placed in front of a candle, they served as a bedside lamp or were hung in front of a window. link on the site
