The work, bathed in a soft light, subtly restores the picturesque and warm atmosphere of an old village. The mastery of the washes and the delicate palette are characteristic of the work of Yvon Masse, a discreet but talented artist, active in the first half of the 20th century. Yvon MASSE (1892-1957) is a French artist still little documented but whose several works circulate on the art market, in particular landscapes, views of villages and rural scenes done in watercolor.
