LAPEL BADGE OF A MEMBER OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF VERSAILLES, created in 1876, Third Republic. 31644RLawl badge called "barometer" in silver and vermeil, depicting a lictor's fasces, in the center radiant sun charged with a branch of oak and laurel leaves, enameled center with the arms of the city of Versailles, in the red rim "Municipal Council - Versailles", fixed by spatula, with silvering hallmark.74.8 x 45 mmWith its wooden case dressed in paper imitating burgundy rectified leather. Interior in ecru satin and dark blue short velvet. Produced by Maison Billard de Paris.France.Third Republic.Very good condition.
