The latter has disappeared as well as the right hand Good state of conservation, nevertheless, despite these few lacks Elizabeth of Hungary (July 7, 1207 - November 17, 1231) also known as Elizabeth of Thuringia Princess of Hungary, she was engaged at the age of 4 and married at 14 to the Landgrave of Thuringia. A loving wife, she was widowed at 20 and refused any other marriage Influenced by the spirit of St. Francis, she put herself at the service of the poor and would become the symbol of Christian

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charity She was canonized by the Catholic
Church on May 27, 1235
