Description

- Lalique France Royat vase, conical shape, pressed and molded in clear and frosted crystal, decorated with straight lines in relief with a geometric triangular zigzag pattern with serrated ribs ending in rounded protrusions on the edge of the neck of the vase. - Model created on April 28, 1936 by René Lalique (1860-1945). - Cursive signature in Lalique France point under the underside of the base of the vase. - Since 1945, with the death of René Lalique and the Lalique crystal factory switching from glass to crystal, the Lalique France signature has been used to certify crystal objects produced by the Lalique crystal factory.- Note: scratches and rubbing under the base of the vase, consistent with the age and use of the vase, but in no way detracting from the quality of the vase.- Model referenced in the book
