Beautiful birdcage by K. Griesbaum, made in Germany around 1960. This small cage houses a bird that, when the mechanism is activated, turns from left to right, flaps its wings, moves its tail, and opens and closes its beak in time with the melody it whistles. This type of work by Griesbaum is rare--most of his creations are his famous songbird boxes. A drawer at the base also allows this charming object to be used as a jewelry box. Brief history of K. Griesbaum: Karl Griesbaum founded his workshop in the Black Forest at the beginning of the 20th century. The company quickly made a name for itself with its exceptional songbird boxes, renowned for their precise mechanics, realistic movements, and refined decoration. From the 1920s to the 1960s, his creations were exported worldwide. Birdcages
