Known for her genre, animal, and still life paintings, she debuted with heroeuvre at the Paris Salon in 1868. She married history painter AlphonseMuraton, and her son Louis Muraton was also a painter. She became a member of The Society of French Artists from 1888, andreceived a bronze medal at 'L'Exposition Universelle' in 1889. Her work isrepresented in a number of French museums, including the Museum of Rouen, Le Havre,
