A large and beautiful decorative dish...In colored glazed earthenware...A slip...!From the end of the 19th century...In perfect condition...!Just a lack of enamel around the edge of the heel on the back, it is a manufacturing defect, on one of the three support points for cooking...All the colors are very fresh...With two artist initials, CB...I am not sure despite knowing the city well if it is from the MONTEREAU factory...!I should know more in a while...!And represented in relief...The coat of arms of the city is its motto..."Urbs Antiqua Condaté" written in Latin...For "Ville Antique Au Confluent"...With the key dates...That of 1419...For Montereau-Fault-Yonne, it is the site of multiple clashes during the Hundred Years' War (Jean sans peur I of Burgundy was assassinated there in 1419...That of 1590...The
