Very beautiful vintage ceramic vase by Fernand Elchinger, model called Infini, circa 1950. A brief history of Maison Elchinger: Established in Alsace in 1834, the family business "Céramiques Elchinger" has perpetuated the art of ceramics since that time, with successive generations offering a production that is as varied as it is avant-garde. Léon Elchinger (1871-1942) will mark the spirits with artistic stoneware productions as well as very beautiful Art Nouveau and then Art Deco pottery. Less known than ceramists such as Pol Chambost, Jacques & Dany Ruelland, George Jouve or Roger Capron, Fernand Elchinger (1911-1975) will nevertheless distinguish himself as one of the great ceramists of the middle of the 20th century. His creations very often adopt free forms, or soft forms, which
