Description

The bronze sculpture with a golden patina, created by Émile Carlier (1849-1927), offers a striking tribute to the Alpine hunters, those seasoned soldiers specialized in fighting in mountainous terrain. True to his artistic commitment, Carlier immortalizes here the determination and elegance of these soldiers through a detailed and expressive work. The Alpine hunter is represented in full march, his rifle firmly held and his backpack loaded, thus illustrating the harshness of the missions these soldiers faced. Each fold of his uniform, each accessory is meticulously crafted, testifying to the care taken by the sculptor in the faithful representation of this elite military corps. With its golden patina, the sculpture acquires a particular depth and solemnity, giving the impression that
