Frans Tuinstra, abstract/cubist ceramic sculpture, 1972. Monogrammed in the decoration, signed and dated on the back. Perfect condition. Frans Tuinstra (1923-2006), Dutch ceramicist and visual artist, was born in Maastricht in 1923. Considered one of the most important Dutch ceramicists of the post-war period, he trained at the Stadsacademie in Maastricht and, after working for Russel-Tiglia, founded his own studio in Neercanne in 1956. His work includes ceramic sculptures, wall reliefs, sculpted vases, and geometric sgraffito compositions in a modernist style that blends abstraction, brutalism, and stylized figuration. Among his most famous public works is the large architectural relief on the Maastorenflat in Rotterdam (1956), followed by numerous commissions for hospitals, schools,

and municipal buildings. Tuinstra favored chamotte, raw earth, and matte glazes, creating pieces with a refined, symbolic aesthetic. He also taught at the KCV center in Maastricht, influencing a new generation of artists. He died in Eindhoven in 2006. His work, both monumental and poetic, remains sought after by collectors and is valued for its contribution to the integration of art into the Dutch public space.
